

Guardian/Student Policy Acceptance

Mission/Vision & Curriculum

- I understand that Dual Immersion Academy is a chartered public school with a specific mission, vision and philosophy. I have read the school's mission, vision and philosophy and commit to support the school in the pursuit and fulfillment of its goals
- I understand that Dual Immersion Academy provides an academically challenging curriculum program. I will support the school in the chosen curriculum. I will supervise my child at home, review his/her grades on line regularly, and ensure that assignments are completed in a timely manner.
- I understand that parents of Dual Immersion Academy are expected to minimize their children's absences and tardies. I will make earnest efforts to schedule appointments and lessons outside of school hours and bring my student to school on time.

Family Involvement
